TORAHSPARKS

A PROJECT OF THE ATLANTA SCHOLARS KOLLEL

With the upcoming festival of *Pesach* quickly approaching, we turn our attention to the central event of the entire festival, the *Seder* and its accompanying *mitzvos*. Of significance is providing a little clarity concerning the primary text that our Sages composed as a guide to the 15 steps of the *Seder* experience – the *Haggadah*.

The *Haggadah* is a collection of the teachings and statements of the Sages of the times of the *Mishna*. Our Sages established upon us an obligation to not only to merely *recite* the *Haggadah*, but also to *learn it ourselves* and to *teach it to our children* every year at the *Seder*.

From a superficial viewpoint, it seems as though there is no rhyme or reason for the numerous sections of the *Haggadah*, strung together in seeming disarray. It would seem worthy to investigate the reason behind the order of the *Haggadah* as we have it, to find the thread that binds that *Haggadah*, from beginning to end, finding a common denominator that ties together each passage and each topic.

The *Seder* is more than just a ritual. As the famed Rabbi and Torah commentator **Malbim** (1809-1879) writes, the entire evening is an educational experience. We must learn at the Seder, and we should teach at the Seder. If the instructor does not prepare lessons before they are delivered, the inadequacy is clearly apparent to the students attending the lesson. We, therefore, must review the *Haggadah* before we sit down at the table on *Pesach* night. We must spend time and effort to assure that we properly educate and become educated at the *Seder*. We can not begin to deal with understanding the order of the Seder if we are not first familiar with the parts that together compose the Seder. Pesach involves much preparation. There is the cleaning, the cooking, and the arranging. This preparation should surely include reviewing the *Haggadah*. Understanding the order of the *Seder* is part of this process.
